## BLS Medication Formulary

1. Albuterol MDI prescribed to patient ( Beta Agonist)
2. Aspirin
3. EpiPen Adult / Pediatric
4. Glucose Oral (Glucose solutions)
5. Naloxone (Narcan) *Sponsor Hospital approved*
6. Nitroglycerine – Sublingual prescribed to patient
7. Oxygen
